Sir,

In inviting a reference to Ministry of Finance, (Department of Expenditure) O.M. No.F.19(1) 1C/86 dated 24-7-90 (copy enclosed) regarding recommendation of revised scale of pay and revised designation of existing Library Staff under Central Government, I am directed to say that the pay scale attached to the post of Assistant Librarian in North Eastern Council Secretariat is Rs.1350-2200/- and as per recommendation mentioned above the pay scale has been revised to Rs.1400-2600/-. Accordingly, the post of Assistant Librarian of N.E.C. Secretariat needs to be upgraded to the pay scale of Rs.1400-2600/-. As regards other categories of Library Staff only revised designation appears to be done. The position of Library Staff are shown below :-

G.S.R. 744.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the North Eastern Council Secretariat, Shillong (Group 'A' Group 'B' and Group 'D' posts) Recruitment Rules, 1983, the North Eastern Council Secretariat, Shillong (Group 'A' and Group 'B' posts) Recruitment Rules, 1984, the North Eastern Council Secretariat, Shillong (Group 'A' and Group 'B') Recruitment Rules, 1985 and the North Eastern Council Secretariat, Shillong (Group 'A' and Group 'B' posts) Recruitment Rules, 1985, in so far as they relate to the posts of Senior Technical Assistant, Assistant Engineer, Librarian (Grade I) and Senior Technical Assistant (Engineering), except as respects things done or omitted to have been done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the Group 'B' posts in the Office of the North Eastern Council Secretariat, Shillong, namely :—

1. Short title and commencement.—(1) These rules may be called the North Eastern Council Secretariat, Shillong (Group 'B' posts) Recruitment Rules, 1987.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the official Gazette.

2. Number of posts, classification and scale of pay.—The number of the said posts, their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in column 2 to 4 of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications etc.—The method of recruitment to the said posts, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns 5 to 14 of the said Schedule.

4. Disqualification.—No person—

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person having a spouse living; or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person;

shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts :

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax.—Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may be order for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Saving.—Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Ex-Servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regards.

Circumstances in which Union Public Service Commission is to be consulted in making recruitment

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Promotion/Transfer on Deputation (including short-term contract) :

I. Officers in the North Eastern region under the Central/State Governments/Union Territories/Recognised Research Institutes/Public Sector Undertakings/Statutory, Semi-Government or Autonomous bodies :

- (a) (i) holding analogous posts on regular basis; or
(ii) with 5 years' regular service in post in the scale of Rs. 1640-60-2600-75-2900 or equivalent; and
(iii) with 8 years' regular service in post in the scale of Rs. 1400-40-1800-50-2300 or equivalent; and
(b) Possessing Bachelor's degree and Degree or equivalent Diploma in Library Science from a recognised University or equivalent.

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II. The departmental Librarian in the scale of Rs. 1640-60-2600-75-2900 with 5 years' regular service in the grade will also be considered and in case he is selected for appointment to the post, the same shall be deemed to have been filled by promotion. (The departmental officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion will not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly, deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion. Period of deputation/contract including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organisation/department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed 3 years).

Group 'B' Departmental Promotion Committee (for considering confirmation)

1. Secretary North Eastern Council—Chairman
2. Deputy Secretary, or above in the North Eastern Council Division of MHA—Member
3. Director General (Backward Classes Welfare) of his nominee or appropriate status—Member

Note : The proceeding of the Departmental Promotion Committee relating to confirmation shall be sent to the Commission for approval. If, however, these are not approved by the Commission a fresh meeting of the Departmental Promotion Committee to be presided over by the Chairman or a Member of the Union Public Service Commission shall be held.

Selection on each occasion shall be made in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission.
