# Tour Note of Shri Ram Muivah, IAS, Secretary, NEC from 31<sup>st</sup> January to 2<sup>nd</sup> February 2016 to Tripura

- 1. Called on Governor of Tripura Shri Tathagata Roy on 31<sup>st</sup> January at 4.30 pm. Briefed the Hon'ble Governor of Tripura (Member of NEC Plenary Council) regarding the various activities, achievements & vision of NEC. In course of the briefing the undersigned also apprised the Hon'ble Governor urgent issues and challenges of the NEC. The undersigned also apprised the Hon'ble Governor the good practices such as multi-layered monitoring system in practice in NEC. The Hon'ble Governor was very gracious and also appreciative of the NEC. He has advised for revitalization and strengthening of NEC.
- 2. Called on Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tripura Shri Manik Sarkar on 1<sup>st</sup> February at 12.30 pm. #### (E) Projects retained for the Current FY 2015-16.

Five projects were retained in respect of Tripura in the current FY 2015-16 amounting to Rs. 96.36 crores. Tripura Govt has submitted DPRs and they requested release of 1<sup>st</sup> instalment.

#### (F) NERLP:

In course of inspection of NERLPS (North East Livelihood Promotion Society) projects the undersigned had interesting interaction with the SHGs under NERLP. After initial hiccup NERLP has taken off the ground in Tripura, with a modest grant of Rs 1.00 lakh as seed fund per SHG. The life of SHG members (about 10-15 per SHG, all women mostly from remote rural areas) has been transformed. The SHG members availed loan @2% interest from the seed fund for taking up livelihood projects such as rearing goats, cows, fishery, vegetable kitchen garden, grocery shops, potato, cabbage farming etc.

For instance, one old woman took a modest loan of Rs 3000.00 and with it bought four numbers of small goats and she was rearing them with so much care & affection. Another woman took a loan of Rs 7000.00 only and with it bought a cow. Another SHG member took a loan of Rs 10,000.00 & with it bought 5000 fish fingerlings for her pond. Another SHG Member borrowed a sum of Rs 10,000.00 and she has successfully implemented a cabbage farm - all organic. The undersigned witnessed many more success stories of NERLP project in Tripura.

In course of interaction with the SHGs, they requested that they want to be imparted trainings – in tailoring, knitting etc. Since it was not possible for these simple village women to go to Guwahati to undergo training, it was decided to depute trainers to respective village of the SHGs.
