Subject: Forwarding of Inspection Report.

In inviting a reference to the above subject, as requested by the concerned Sector, the physical inspection of the project "Construction of Sport Complex at Indira Gandhi National Tribal University, Regional Campus, Manipur (IGNTU-RCM) at Manipur." was carried out in Manipur. The inspection report duly signed by the Executive Engineer (C), Consultant (CE) and Consultant (ME), NEC is enclosed herewith. The project was sanctioned on 05/03/2014 at a total cost of Rs. 956.61 lakhs (NEC's share 100%). The Project cost was then revised and the revised sanction was on 09/03/2018 at a cost of Rs. 943.32 lakhs. Three instalments totalling Rs. 865.55 Lakhs were released by the NEC.

The inspection, inter alia, mentioned that:

- The works were in progress. The Implementing Department has informed that they have not received the third installment of Rs. 100.00 lakhs from the IGNTU, which was released by NEC on 18/01/2018.
- The physical progress and financial progress is not commensurate.
- The volume of earth work that may be required to be excavated at the site is more or less equal to the provision of earth work as per approved revised DPR which is 32,684.2m<sup>3</sup> (for football field).
- The Construction of the Gallery and Indoor Stadium was done as per the approved
- The excess excavated earthwork was found being dumped/stacked within the campus of
- No signboard was found at the site acknowledging that the project is funded by NEC.
- The project has already suffered from time overrun of 26 months with effect from the date of release of the first installment. Hence, the progress of work has to be further expedited.

This is for information and necessary action by the concerned Sector.

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# (III) Observations/ Status of works (Physical Achievements):

The following observations were made on the basis of the visit to the project site with reference to the revised DPR, which was approved by NEC on 06<sup>th</sup> March, 2018 and interactions with the officials of the implementing agency.

## (V) Overall Remarks and Suggestions:-

- 1. Overall it can be said that the works were in progress. The Implementing Department has informed that they have not received the third installment of Rs. 100.00 lakhs from the IGNTU, which was released by NEC on 18/01/2018.
- 2. The Implementing Department has received two installments from IGNTU i.e. Rs. 7,66.55 lakhs (NEC Share) and from this amount the implementing department should have completed the Construction of gallery (Rs. 4,17,74,501), Construction of Indoor Stadium (Rs. 2,54,18,866) and 96% of earth excavation for Construction of eight lane 400 metre track and football field development. But as per site condition it could be seen that after having received and also utilized both the installments, the Implementing department have not yet completed the construction of gallery and indoor stadium. Hence, from this it can be said that the physical progress and financial progress is not commensurate, The Implementing department should complete the remaining works as per specification mentioned in revised approved DPR.
- 3. No signboard was found at the site acknowledging that the project is funded by NEC.

4. It is suggested that excess excavated earthwork may kindly be disposed off to designated site.










