#### Observation mentioned in inspection report:

- On inspection it is found that without taking into consideration the GST, labour cess, Contingency & agency charges the Physical and Financial progress does not commensurate. Out of the 80 % of funds released by NEC, approximately 63% has been utilised.
- During inspection it was found that the construction of basement floor was not done, the implementing agency didn't construct the basement floor in fact the construction was started from ground floor
- The works for the setting up of multi-Disciplinary Livelihood incubation centre for food processing, Readymade garment making and Handicraft at Hunpun till date the progress of works at site is about 80%, thus structural details such as Reinforcement details, and concrete mix design etc could not be checked.
- For the construction of third and fourth floor, concrete works, RCC works is in progress, whereas in the case of the 1<sup>st</sup> floor level of the building the works related to brickwork was half done
- The plinth area of the **building** was found to be 503.75mtrs and the measurements in the building which include the **sizes** of the **rooms**, sizes of **columns** (500 x 500)and (4700 x 470) mm<sup>2</sup>, **staircase** detail constructed is more or less the **same** as that of the approved drawings in the DPR.
- Remaining sanitary works, electrification works, and other miscellaneous, the implementing agency verbally informed that the remaining works will be started as soon as the building is completed..
- Brickwork in foundation, plinth, and upto half portion of the superstructure has been done at site.
- Woodwork, steel work, flooring works has not yet started.
- Remaining Development works like boundary wall gate, air conditioning external electrification, furnishing not yet started.
- Regarding the cut off of basement floor the sectors may ask the clarification.
- Regarding successful implementation and aims and objectives it too early to comment, as only civil construction works has been done. On the whole the project proposal is good if proper implementation will boost the trade and see a sharp graphic surge in the income of the people and hence economic growth, ultimate development of the ukhrul region as a whole., raising the standard of living of its principal stakeholders, identifying stakeholders, leaders and suitable counterparts who can contribute to the process of growth and development of the remote region of Ukhrul.
- As majority of the people who are engaged in the said industries are not able to diversify
  their products thereby, resulting in decrease in profits levels. The incubation centre will
  assist in producing market oriented products thereby ensuring competitive advantage and





















